## **INTEGRATION TO THE CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT**

**a.s. 2020/2021**

### **PREMISE**

On May 28, 2020, the Technical Scientific Committee (CTS) of the Civil Protection communicated how **children can return to school safely**:

- they must not have symptoms of breathing difficulties; they must not have a body temperature higher than 37.5 ° C and they must not have had a temperature higher than 37.5 ° C even in the three days before returning to school;
- they must not have been in quarantine or home isolation in the past 14 days;
- they must not have been in contact with positive people in the last 14 days.

Pupils who have symptoms of difficulty breathing or who have a temperature above 37.5 ° C must stay at home.

**The collaboration of parents, who are responsible for the pupils, is very important.**

**CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT – INTEGRATION FOR COVID-19**  
**CONTRAST a.s 2020/2021**

**Parents / exercisers of parental authority / guardians** aware of all the civil and criminal consequences provided by law in the event of false declarations, SIGN THE FOLLOWING CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT for the student \_\_\_\_\_ enrolled in the EIGHTH CIRCLE OF PIACENZA:

**ATTENDANCE IN THE SCHOOL INSTITUTE**

The parent (or holder of parental responsibility) declares:

- to know the rules of conduct to contain the contagion;
- that the son / daughter, or a cohabitant of the son / daughter within the family unit is not subject to the quarantine measure or that it has not tested positive for COVID-19;
- to commit to keeping their child at home if they have a fever (equal to or greater than 37.5 °) to be measured every day before going to school, or if the child has other symptoms such as sore throat, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis, loss of smell or taste and inform the pediatrician immediately of the onset of symptoms or fever;
- to be aware and accept that if your child has a fever equal to or higher than 37.5 ° or if he has other symptoms mentioned above, he will not be admitted to school and will remain at home under his responsibility;
- to be aware and accept that, in case of onset of fever (equal to or greater than 37.5 °) or other symptoms (among those mentioned above), the school immediately isolates the child or adolescent and immediately informs family members;
- to be aware that their child must comply with the health and hygiene guidelines within the school;
- to have been adequately informed by the school of all the organizational and sanitary provisions for safety and for the containment of the risk of spreading the infection from Covid-19;
- not to be allowed to enter school, during the performance of activities and in the presence of children, except for situations of proven emergency;
- to commit to adopting, even at home and in the places that the pupil attends, behaviors of maximum precaution to prevent the risk of contagion;
- to be aware that when school activities resume, even with the utmost attention, it is not possible to avoid the risk of contagion, which instead must be minimized through the scrupulous and rigorous observance of the precautionary and safety measures provided for by specific agreements for the carrying out the activities, (for this reason it is important to observe the utmost caution even outside the school).

In particular, the school during the period of school attendance:

- commits to communicating any changes or additions to the provisions;
- has personnel adequately trained on all aspects concerning the rules on the organization of school services, in particular on health and hygiene procedures to fight the spread of the infection. The staff themselves commit to scrupulously observing all health and hygiene requirements and to go to work only if they do not show symptoms related to Covid-19;
- commits to adopting all the health and hygiene requirements envisaged by the current legislation, including the provisions regarding distancing;
- commits to complying strictly and scrupulously with any disposal of the local health authority, in case of a Covid-19 infection in a child or adult who attends the school.

**The signing of this agreement commits families and the school to respect it in good faith.**
